Covid-19 Response Plan**



The safety and health of our campers and staff is our top priority at the Matt Clark Basketball Camp. We will be following all CDC recommendations and guidelines to create a safe environment for all campers and staff.

If any camper or family member is sick, please stay home! If your camper or anyone in your household is exhibiting symptoms or has been exposed to someone with COVID-19, campers may not return to camp or participate in the basketball camp for 14-days.

Below are all the details regarding the safety and protocols that will take place during the camp:

Frequently Asked Questions:

“How will check-in take place each morning?”

- Check-in will be allowed this year as early as 8:15AM. Please make sure we are following all social distancing guidelines.

“How will check-out take place after camp?”

- Check-out will be allowed this year to be as late as 2:45PM for the afternoon session. It is encouraged that parents wear a mask for check-in and check-out during the camp.

“Do campers need to wear a mask?”

- They will not be required to wear a mask, but if you prefer that they do, they are welcome to do so. It is encouraged for the camper to wear a mask when they cannot social distance. But since basketball requires physical activity, often social distancing is not possible. If there is a specific physical activity that you would not like the camper to participate in, please let Coach Clark know.

“Will there be supplies to support hand hygiene behaviors?”

- Yes. There will be hand sanitize stations around the gymnasium and campers will be encouraged to wash their hands frequently either using hand sanitizer or hand-soap in the bathroom. A staff member will also be disinfecting the gymnasium throughout the day.

“For all-day campers, will lunch be provided?”

- Lunch will be provided this year at camp. Campers may bring a pre-packaged lunch and or purchase pizza and a drink in the concession. If this is not possible, please let Coach Clark know. We will be selling pre-packaged snacks and drinks in which the camper can setup an account during the first day of camp check-in.

If any camper or family member is sick, please stay home! If your camper or anyone in your household is exhibiting symptoms or has been exposed to someone with COVID-19, campers may not return to camp or participate in the basketball camp for 14-days.

If any camper is exhibiting any symptoms during camp, they will be isolated in a room with a staff member until a family member comes and picks them up.
